









## MAKE IT!

Make a small hole in the centre of the plate, on the end of the tail. Use a sharp pencil, compass or awl, as pictured here. Use this to thread some wool through. Tie it on the other side to secure and suspend.








You could try turning your snake into an adder! Here's one we made...
