

SNAKE ROCKS



Materials

- Stones - either local or you can buy them
- Newspaper to cover surface
- Painting apron (optional)
- Poster paints
- Paint brushes
- Water for washing brushes
- Containers to mix colours



Method

- Ensure rocks are clean and dry before painting
- Proceed to paint rocks in a snake theme
- This could be patterns inspired by our native snakes (smooth snake, grass snake or adder)
- Use bold colours! Or use colours you might associate with snake habitat
- Be as creative as possible, go wild
- Leave paint to dry, then coat with a varnish or PV glue to make them weatherproof
- To make your own snake made from the painted rocks, 6+ painted rocks are recommended for the best results - these can be shown off in gardens or at your front door
- Hold onto the finished rocks! And make sure to post your masterpieces on the CARG Facebook page
